- Recognize and accommodate different learning modalities.
 - Provide structure without being overly directive.
 - Listen to and respect each student's point of view.
- Encourage and facilitate students' shared decision-making.
- Help students work through difficulties by asking open-ended questions.



- Make decisions about what and how they will learn.
- Construct new knowledge and skills by building on current knowledge and skills.
 - Use self-assessment measures.
 - Work in collaboration with other students.
- Produce work that demonstrates authentic learning.
