# Financial Aid Office

#### Financial Aid Checklist

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

 Get started on filing your FAFSA by requesting a Personal Identification Number (www.pin.ed.gov). Completing the FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) as soon as possible to maximize your eligibility for state and federal financial aid. Be sure to list Claflin's school code, 003424, on the FAFSA. The FAFSA form is the only financial aid application that Claflin requires. A FAFSA must be completed every year that a student is in college.

#### What are the different types of financial aid?

 By completing the FAFSA, you are applying for all Federal Title IV programs including the Federal Pell Grant, Federal Supplemental Education Opportunity Grant, Federal Work Study, Federal Perkins Loan, Federal Stafford Loans (Subsidized and Unsubsidized) and Federal Parent Plus Loan. It may be offered separately or in combination.

### Is there a deadline for applying?

 We recommend that your application be submitted no later than the priority deadlines set, which are April 15th for the fall semester, October 15th for the spring semester and March 15th for summer session. It is important that you complete the financial aid application process early so that your award will be in place prior to registration deadlines and to avoid processing delays.

#### Follow-up with any necessary paperwork and forms

 All students who file a FAFSA are selected at random by the federal government for review in a process called verification. If you are selected for verification, you will be notified by the federal processors by email and then by Claflin's Office of Financial Aid with a letter. Be sure to turn in all of the requested documents so that the financial aid process can be complete.

Let us know about any special circumstances you and your family may face

 If you and your family experience any unusual circumstances that will have an impact on your finances such as divorce, death of a parent or loss of employment, please let us know. Contact our office for more information about these circumstances.

#### Check out your financial aid package

 Once your financial aid package is complete, you will receive an email with your tentative financial aid award letter attached. At that time, you will be able to accept or decline each of the financial aid options available to you and seek out other loan options, as well.

- 1. If necessary update any change in chapter status via the Department of Veterans Affairs website: Students under Chapters 30, 31, 32, 33, 1606, & 1607 fill out Form 22-1995. Students under Chapter 35 fill out Form 22-5495.
- 2. Complete Claflin University VA Certification Enrollment Form. All Veterans and Dependent students must verify their enrollment each semester.

- 4. Enter your user name. Your username is your complete Claflin e-mail address, including@ claflin.edu
- 5. Enter your password.
  Password is the first initial of your first name, the first initial of your last name, \* (an asterisk), and your student ID Number.

- 1. Go to claflin.bn.college
- 2. Click Textbooks
- 3. Select Find Textbooks
- 4. Select correct term
- 5. Enter course prefix, course number, & course section
- 6. Click find materials

# Accessing Library Services

Steps to access Claflin's H. V. Manning Library Resources from off campus

- 1. Go to the H. V. Manning Library's webpage on your web browser. The link to our webpage is <a href="http://www.claflin.edu/future-students/library/library">http://www.claflin.edu/future-students/library/library</a>
- 2. On the left side of this webpage, there is a "Chat with the Librarian" feature that you can use any time, 24/7. If you have any questions and Claflin Librarians are not available, reference this link!
- 3. If you need to look for an academic article, newspaper article or other online references, click on the Electronic Resources link on the left side of the page.
- 4. Your page should look like this:
- 5. If you need to find a journal article, we recommend searching either EBSCO Host databases or JSTOR (the arrows lead to the icon you need to click to reach that database).
- 6. When you click on either of these database icons when you are not on Claflin's campus, there will be a yellow pop up window (you will have to be in a web browser that has pop-ups enabled) that looks like this:
- 7. This window lets you verify that you are a Claflin Student. In the Claflin Username, enter your Claflin email but leave off the "@claflin.edu" Example: If my Claflin email is <a href="mailto:tperson@claflin.edu">tperson@claflin.edu</a>, I would enter **tperson** in the box for Username.
- 8. For Password, enter the same Password that you use to log into your Claflin Email. If that password has changed or expired, you need to speak to our IT Department. Their phone number is 803-535-5767.
- 9. If you have not used these databases before or need a refresher, feel free to call either Ms. Morgan Montgomery (803-535-5316) or Mr. Chess Schmidt (803-535-5318) and we would be happy to help walk you through using the databases
