



## New Features to Moodle 3.2 – For Students

### Theme and Navigation

- A new theme, Boost, offers a responsive navigation menu.
- The navigation drawer located on the left side of the navigation bar can replace blocks. It can be opened and closed to free up space.

### Communication

- New icons next to the user drop-down menu display personal messages and alerts about assignments, badges, and discussion posts.

### Discussion Forums

- Forum posts have a permalink so that important posts are easily shared.
- Forums can now be locked to prevent any further replies or posts.

### Folder Bulk Downloads

- Download all files within a folder at once so that they can be accessed offline.





### Competencies (CBE)

If configured by the instructor, competencies are used to gauge the level of understanding in a specific subject. They can be accessed through the user menu in the navigation bar or a block on the student dashboard.

- Students can see the competencies linked their course(s).
  - View learning plans.
  - Check progress.
  - Upload evidence and link to a competency.
- Request a review.

### Grade Annotation

- Your instructors can add notes directly to your .docx and .pdf documents.
