Changes From Moodle 2.8 to Moodle 3.0

Navigation

- **My home** page is now called **Dashboard**.
- User menu now includes **Grades** and **Preferences** page.
 - Links to **Courses I am taking** and **Courses I am teaching**
 - Displays current grades for all courses
 - All preferences are housed on a hyperlinked menu.
- User-specific links (such as profile settings and reports), which were previously located in the **Navigation** and **Administration** blocks, are now housed on the profile page.

Course Editing

- Module editing is now a drop-down menu.
 - Delete enables users to delete an entire module, including its contents.
- You can display the date a file or resource was uploaded or changed.

Text Editor

- Image drag and drop is now enabled in Atto.
- The equation editor button is available if math equation filter(s) are enabled.
- The enhanced table editor allows border styling, sizing, and colors.

Quizzes

- You can add section headings to each new quiz page.
- You can shuffle questions by section, as opposed to shuffling all questions.
- Question availability can depend on a previous question being answered.
- Four new question types are available:
 - Select missing words
 - Drag and drop into text
 - Drag and drop into image
 - Drag and drop markers

Messaging

- You can send messages via a pop-up box without navigating away from the profile page.
- You can now delete unwanted messages from your inbox view.

Forums

- Only one post is required for all groups in a forum.
