


Step	Screenshot
<p>1. Under the Content tab, click the Profile pictures tab.</p> <p>You will see the Profile pictures tab as shown above.</p>	<p>See above</p>

Anyone who can access your portfolio may see the information in this area.



Uploading a Picture

Step	Screenshot
<p>2. Click the Browse button in the section titled Upload profile picture at the end of the Profile picture* field.</p>	
<p>3. Select the file you wish to use as your profile picture.</p> <p>The path to the file will appear in the Profile picture* field.</p>	
<p>If you wish to give the image a title, click in the Image title field and type the title. This will not change the file name.</p>	
<p>4. Click Upload.</p>	
<p>The image will appear in the Profile pictures list above the Upload profile picture section.</p>	



Note

When you finish these steps, the picture will be stored on both the server and your personal computer. When people access the file, they will see the picture from the server. They will not have access to your computer.
